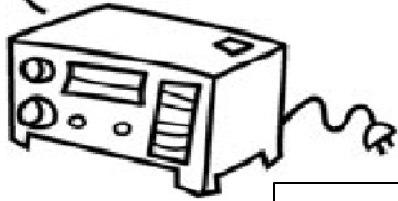

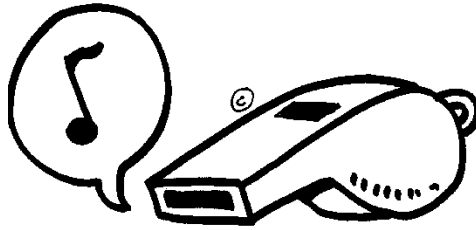

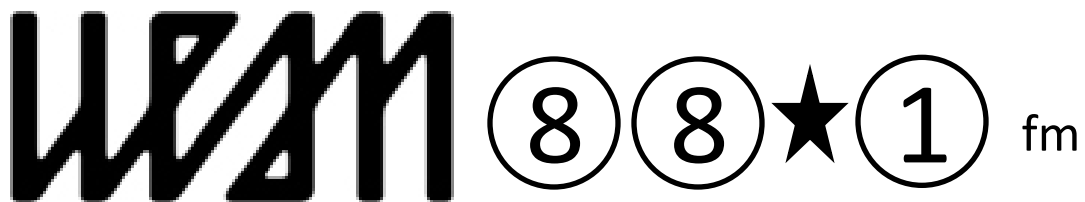
Music Review Committee: Want to hear newly-released and soon-to-be released music before anyone else? Join the music review committee!
